

New Trash Policy

The Williamsburg Board of Directors desires to improve the neighborhood and living conditions by establishing a policy on the purchase and use of trash carts. The policy is the result of continued trash issues around the cooperatives grounds. This Policy was discussed multiple times and approved on by the Board of Directors.

New Policy as follows:

- 1) New Trash Carts to be used will be purchased by Williamsburg Coop and will be the property of Williamsburg Coop. The cart will remain with the individual unit and be the responsibility of the unit member. *If you have already purchased a GFL cart you will be reimbursed by the Cooperative with a proof of purchase.
- 2) All units are to use a GFL trash cart with an attached lid to store garbage in; at the back of their unit. **GFL – Green for Life residential waste management company*
- 3) Large household furnishings or appliances will be collected at curbside. Any appliance that contains Freon gas such as refrigerators and freezers (for safety remove all doors) and air conditioners may be set out at the curb on your scheduled day. GFL is responsible to have the freon removed by a licensed technician at no cost to the resident. Residents may also place washers, dryers, water heaters, stoves, furnaces, microwaves, garbage disposals, trash compactors, heat pumps, water softeners and other large and small appliances curbside.
- 4) Trash in bags will no longer be permitted to be placed in the collection areas.
- 5) All trash in collection areas are to be contained in a GFL can. Place your trash, yard waste, and recycling at the pick area between 6:00 p.m. Tuesday and before 7:00 a.m. on Wednesday. It's also the law; City Ordinance #35.258
- 6) Members must label GFL Carts with member's address in **SHARPIE MARKER** and they will also be registered with the city to your individual address. Make sure to label your cart so not to get mistaken with any other; if you cannot do this please call the office as we have volunteers that will label them for you.
- 7) This policy to be established as of December 2019 and can be reviewed by the Board of Directors at their discretion.
- 8) If you wish to recycle GFL will supply a 64-gallon recycling container at no charge to residents who request one. Call them directly at 1-866-772-8900 for this FREE service.
